



Adult Family Care

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The **Incompass Adult Family Care (AFC)** program supports elders and adults with disabilities who wish to remain in a home setting. Family members most often provide these in-home supports, but it is not a requirement of the AFC program. Non-relatives are encouraged to be caregivers as well. Benefits of the program include monthly stipends for caregivers, home visits from our dedicated nursing team, and 24-hour assistance via phone and/or email.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE SUPPORTS?

- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Must be MassHealth eligible
- Must have a medical, physical, or developmental disability that prevents them from living independently, and needs supervision or assistance with at least one basic task of everyday life (e.g., eating, bathing, etc.)

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY AS A CAREGIVER?

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Any family member, or non-relative, **except for** legal guardians and spouses
- Must be able to meet daily care needs of program participants

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT?

The intake process begins with a phone interview with our AFC manager. Once basic eligibility is determined, an in-home consultation is scheduled with an AFC staff member and nurse for further evaluation.
